

### Basic Archaeology Skills Taster

A two-hour taster session will introduce you to archaeology through participating on an archaeological dig. There will also be an opportunity to try another archaeological skill, such as planning an archaeological feature, using a surveyor's level and simple finds identification.

Over two-days you will be introduced to a range of basic archaeological fieldwork skills and techniques through tuition and hands-on participation. You will gain first hand experience of identifying and setting out a site and the excavating, cleaning and recording of an archaeological feature. You will also gain an understanding of Health and Safety issues relevant to archaeological sites.



By successfully completing this two-day course you will have the opportunity to gain an AQA accreditation.
