 given to God to performe) doe make and ordaine this my last will and
 Testament in manner and forme followinge: First I bequeath my
 Soule into the hande of Almighty God evermore by the merite of his death and
 passion of my Soule and alone redemer Jesus Christ and my body
 to be buried in convenient place at the discretion of my exors
 I do give unto Henry, Wylliam, Christopher and Alice, my children
 each of them a Cowe bullcote; and also a piece of good and lawfull
 money of England; and each of them a pair of English, a platter
 and a dyss. I do give unto Agnes my wyfe my house and
 all my lande in the parish of Widdelham for the space of Twelve years
 next after my decease: And if yt shall happen the sayd Agnes my
 wyfe to dye before the sayd Twelve years be expyred then my wyfe and
 heirs in yt the sayd house and lande to be enjoyed by her my wyfe and
 at her death shall remayne porchard and portion like amongst my children.
 I do give unto Christopher my son a badde and all things belon-
 ginge thereto. I do give unto Elizabeth my daughter my cowe
 and bequeath unto Agnes my wyfe, reason I make execution of this
 my last will and Testament; And I ordeyne and make overseers of this
 my last will and Testament John Spelt and John Taylor and I give
 unto each of them xiij^s and above their charges.
