 lambe and some sheepe or the value in money, And I give to Thomas Garding his
 daughter Marye by the name of one sheepe or ewe at the discretion of my executor
 to be delivered and paid wthin six monthes after my deathe, And I give to the said
 Thomas Garding six shillings in ewes, wthin six monthes after my deathe, And I give
 to my sonne with moore some sheepe and one ewe, to be delivered and paid wthin
 six monthes after my deathe, And I give to my sonne John moore some sheepe or ewes
 to be paid as before said, And I give to my sonne Edward moore one sheepe or ewe
 at the discretion of my executor, to be paid as before said, And I give to my sonne
 Edward his daughter Anne Jane one ewe and a lambe, and to her sister Anne and
 Jane, to be paid as before said, And I give to my daughter Anne and ewe and a
 lambe, and to her daughter I give a ewe and lambe to be paid as before said, And I
 give to my daughter Anne one ewe and a lambe and to her sonne Thomas
 one ewe and a lambe, And I give to my daughter Katherine moore etc. to be paid to her
 at the day of her marriage and if in the mean tyme she should be married, then the
 part betwixt her sonne Katherine with and John moore equally divided, And the
 residue of my goods and chattels movable and immovable my debts paid and my
 funerall discharges wch my legittime about bequeathed, I doe give and bequeath to
 Thomas my wife, wch she doth make my full Executor of, this my last will and
 Testament And I doe ordaine John Garding and John moore, my over seers
 and overseers to be aydinge to the this my will performed according to the hand
 writinge hereof, and I doe give to them six shillings, And I ratifie and establish
 this my will and Testament utterly revoakinge all former wills gifts grants or
 bequestes by me heretofore made given or granted In witness whereof I have
 hereunto sett my hand and seale the day and year in here written
