 seconde year of the Reigne of our Soveraigne Lord James By the Grace of God King of  
 England, Scotland, France, & Irelande Defender of the faithe etc And in the sight and  
 presence of his Reigne in Scotlande of William Store of Orkney in the Countie  
 of Sundry woman beinge sick in Bedde Northfolke in respect Remembred & Remembred be to  
 Almighty God of Dec ordayne, make, and declare, this my last will and Testament  
 in manner and forme followinge, that is to say, **First** I Comend my Soule to  
 my only Saviour, maker, and Redemer to truste in him and to charge him only to  
 give and bequeath unto Thomas Store my Sonne Twenty Shillings of Lawfull  
 money of Englande to be paid unto him within one whole year next after my decease  
**Item** I Give and bequeath unto William Store my Sonne the Eight pounds of  
 Lawfull money of Englande to be paid unto him within one year after my decease  
 and of the said ~~year~~ next after my decease **Item** I Give and bequeath unto  
 Store my Sonne Eight pounds of Lawfull money of Englande to be paid unto him  
 within three years after my decease **Item** I bequeath unto John Store my daughter  
 Ten pounds of Lawfull money of Englande to be paid unto her within one year after  
 my decease **Item** I Give and bequeath unto John Store my Sonne Twenty  
 pounds of Lawfull money of Englande to be paid in manner & forme followinge, viz Ten  
 pounds when he shall accomplish the Age of one & Twenty years And the other  
 I bequeath unto John Store my daughter the younger Twelve pounds of Lawfull  
 money of Englande to be paid unto her when she shall accomplish the Age of  
 Twenty years **Item** I bequeath unto Agnes Store my daughter Twelve  
 pounds of Lawfull money of Englande to be paid unto her when she shall be of the Age  
 of Twenty years **Item** I bequeath unto Richard Store my Sonne Twelve pounds  
 of Lawfull money of Englande to be paid unto him when he shall accomplish the Age of  
 Twenty years And I Give unto him one Fellowship which all that day belongs  
 unto Elizabeth Store my daughter Twelve pounds of  
 Lawfull money of Englande to be paid unto her when she shall accomplish the Age of  
 Twenty years **Item** I bequeath unto Sara Store my daughter Twelve pounds  
 of Lawfull money of Englande to be paid unto her when she shall accomplish the Age  
 of Twenty years **Alwaies provided** that if it shall please God to call  
 his more any of my Children above mentioend out of this sinfull world before the  
 day or dayes of the payment of the said small Summe or Summes of money by me bequeathed or bequeath  
 they or any out of them shall accomplish their said ages at aforesaid that they my money  
 will and mynd is, that the portions or portions of them or any out of them so deceasinge to  
 remaine to them that shall be livinge to be equally divided amonge them when they  
 any of them shall be of full Age as aforesaid **All** my said legacies so by me Given and  
 bequeathed to be paid by my Executors hereunder named **The Residue** of all  
 my Goods Chattell and Chattell what soever after my debts paid and my Bodie humbly  
 buried I Give and bequeath unto John Store my wellbelovd wyfe whom I make  
 whole Executor of this my last will and Testament And she to take my Debtes  
 pay my Debtes and to see this my last will and Testament fulfilled and  
 in all payntes as my last will is in her so to doe according to the true intent and  
 meaning hereof, viz I do unto her for the Great trust I have in her towards  
 my Children and magntifyinge vpp of my said Children in the feare of Gods yet  
 notwithstandinge provided that if John Store my wyfe be so ~~off~~ disposed to Contract  
 in Matrimonye with any man before all the said small legacies by me Given be paid



According to the true meanings of this my last Testament that thou my very mynd is  
 that the said thons my wyf so contractinge shall before the said tyme of marriage day or  
 be paid or delivred unto my Oldservant named <sup>by my overseer</sup> ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> ~~value~~ <sup>value</sup> ~~thereof~~ <sup>thereof</sup> And  
 or not paid & discharged or so much God as shall be thought worthy <sup>by my overseer</sup> ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> ~~value~~ <sup>value</sup> ~~thereof~~ <sup>thereof</sup> And  
 they to have the Government of the said ~~Stocks~~ <sup>Stocks</sup> to be employed to the most benefit and  
 advantage of my Children to whom it doth or may appertaine Also I ordeine  
 and mak, John Stone the Elder, Nathl Bax, John Amstable, and Richard Margetson  
 my wellbelovd frinds Overseers of this my last will and Testament to see that my  
 mynd and meaning to be fulfilled according to the meaning hereof as my trust is in them  
 so to doe And they to be paid for all costs expens & charges that they or any of them  
 shall or may susteyne in that behalf in any wise And so I have into thy protection of
