to j^e bone and sequynt to my eldest sonnes & abode woodat^e
tene pounds of currant monie of england to j^e send to my younger
sonnes Jane woodat^e tene pounds likewy^r weight fenne^r of
monie my wylle is that my wiffe shall paye fortheselling yarles
during the tyme of tene years ent of my lande after my decesse
and further more my wylle is that if either of them doe die agyn
portion to remaine to the other, And if the mother doe not lye
by hym to paye the sole lande & gome that is payed to be
equallis to be devide betwix them by such portions as
overcometh And also the forfayte sume of xlii yarles to be payed
by my exenters to the overseers to be put to the rest of my
aide bytidenes to best to their profit no tyme shall be intermed
communite and not axid for tyme & the rest of my goodes not
sequynt my debtes payed my funeralle discharged I send to Jane
my wiffe wth me I make my sole exenters of this my last wylle
and testament diversours hearentes lawerant woodat^e and
Nigolas Harrison and for their paines and knyft I comitt unto
them I send them iij^r a p^rce. And also the rest for gome
pounds aij^r likewy^r.
