Woodat of the County of Midd^{le}sex one pound of Lawfull money of
England the said Thomas Woodat the said pound of Lawfull money of
England my will is that my wyffe shall have full power fulling yearlie
during the termes of twenty years out of my Lande after my decease
and further more my will is that if either of them doe die before
the tyme to be paid the said pound of Lawfull money that is paid to be
squally to be divided betwene them by equal portions by my
said wyffe to be paid to the said Thomas Woodat to be put to the use of my
said Thomas Woodat the said pound of Lawfull money shall be paid most
convenient and necessary for them the said Thomas Woodat shall not
be requyred my debts paid my funerall discharged I Comitt to Jane
my wyffe my Cons and Testament Overseers hereunto subscribed to wit
Nicholas Harrison And for their hands and kraft I Comitt unto
them I Comitt to be a Justice. And also the residue for good
