

 our Sovereign Lord James by the grace of God King of England Scotland
 and Ireland Defender of the Faith &c. And of Scotland the one and fourth
 Thomas Mutton of Pirbright in the County of Surrey Gentleman
 do make and ordaine his my last will and Testament in manner and
 followinge that is to saye **first** I commaunde my soule unto Almighty
 my maker and Redeemer havinge in full assurance of my Salvation through
 the merits and passion of Jesus Christ my Saviour. And my body to be
 in the churche of the Holy Trinity of Pirbright aforesaid at the
 of my Exequies. Item I devise unto Anne my wife all my lands
 tenements in Pirbright or elsewhere in the County of Surrey
 all timber woods &c. butill Thomas my Sonne shall arrive to
 full age of 21 years. Upon this condition that my said wife
 for exequies or assignes shall pay and discharge my debts an
 legacies excepted in this my will. That is to saye first
 Summe of 1000^l I owe unto any Creditor I owe whome I will
 shall be paid within four monethes next after my decease
 that is to saye in my now dwelling house at Pirbright
 of Pirbright. And the Summe of 200 pounds to John Habers
 is payable at such time next after the death of the said wife
 assignes shall pay fiftie pounds to Henry my brother in manner
 followinge vizt Ten pounds within eight monethes next after
 my decease. And the forty pounds in full payment of the said 200^l I will
 that he shall pay unto the said Henry within four years after
 the death of the said wife next after the rate of Ten pounds by
 the year. ~~That is to saye~~ Item I will that my said wife for
 exequies or assignes shall pay unto John Habers of
 Pirbright aforesaid six hundred or assignes the summe of 200^l at or
 before the feast day of the Annunciation of our Lady next after
 the year of our Lord God 1600. At the now dwelling house
 of the said John Habers in discharge of a mortgage made
 unto of certain lands of mine called Gurstes fields and Stutfields
 Item I devise unto Anne my daughter the summe of 100^l to be paid
 in manner followinge vizt Ten pounds yearly duringe the tyme of the
 year the first payment to be made at such time as she
 shall arrive to full age of fourteen years next and so after from year
 to year until she be 21 years old and be ended. And until the said
 100^l be fully paid the said 100^l shall be in full payment of the said
 for the said tyme for exequies or assignes be assignes to discharge upon an my lands
 for the same. Item I devise unto Anne my wife
 200^l I will I devise to the churche of the Holy Trinity in
 my said exequies or assignes of this my last will & Testament
 I constitute Henry Mutton and John Habers my overseers of my said
 will and exequies I have be my lands and goods the day and year first
 signed
