daughter in the gift of lawfull English money. And so also of the children of her now at the date hereof
shee hath one one. Item I give & bequeath unto Elizabeth Dauntson my daughter in the gift of lawfull
English money and I give & bequeath & bequeath unto her bullock betweene her two children that
now shee hath. Item I give & bequeath unto Julian Looff my daughter wife of John Looff Esquire
pound of good & lawfull money of England to be paid unto her or her husband or her executor or
assignes in such manner & form as follows, that is to say, first pounced & paid at the end of one yeare
next after my decease, and first pounced at the end of two yeares next after my decease, and first
pounded & paid at the end of three yeares next after my decease. And all the same some of lawfull
money to be paid unto her or her executor or assigns at the end of the said yeares & pounced & paid
