ment as followeth. Myssy 28. 1594.

First I bequeath my soules into the hand of almighty god my soules &
redeemer. And my body to be buried in the churchyard of Woking,
And I give to the parson of the parish of Woking 2 s.

I give to my some house one ewe & one lamb of the best.
And I give to my daughter Marys forty shillinge in one ewe & one lamb

And I give to my daughter some wether forty shillinge & one ewe and
one lamb. And my will is that first 3. years shalbe payd
at the marriage of her mother if she do marry againe,
if she do not marry at what tyme they shalbe of her age
of one and twenty years.

And I give the rest of my goods moveable & immoveable not before given
awaye to Alice Synard my wife whom I make my sole & whole
executrix of this my last will & testament. And I desire
my good friends Thomas Rogers and John Skinning of Woking
and John Lee the younger to be my overseers.
