 his my present Testament and last will in manner and form following  
 I bequeath my soule to Almighty god my onlie saviour and redemer and my body  
 to be buried in such place as you shall please Almighty god to call me  
 to his mercie that I will and give and bequeath the xxij<sup>th</sup> of the County of North  
 Twenty shillings that I will give and bequeath to my mother five pound yearly  
 out of my lands living and being in the County of North to you term of your life  
 to be paid by your heirs to you quarterly the first three years and bequeath to my sister  
 Jane Smyth five pound yearly to be paid by you one yere after my decease  
 that I will give and bequeath to John the abbe of Wyke five pound yearly and  
 if it so be that you shall give to our said Countess five hundred shillings  
 yearly that I will give and bequeath to my wife and you shall accomplish  
 your full age of one and twenty years to you to be paid yearly five  
 hundred shillings that I will give and bequeath to John Smyth five pound yearly  
 that I will give and bequeath to my godson Richard of North five shillings that I will  
 give and bequeath to my godson George of North five shillings that I will give  
 and bequeath to Jane my wife all my lands and goodes during your life excepte  
 you shall give to the heirs of my body lawfulli the xxij<sup>th</sup> of the County of North  
 some of the lands upon the said accomplish your full age of one and twenty years  
 and if the said Jane my wife shall give to the said Countess by my body  
 lawfulli the xxij<sup>th</sup> of the County of North to remain for want of issue to the Countess  
 and his heirs his my heirs and lands called or known by the name of North  
 that I will make and ordain Jane my wife my sole executrix to see my debts  
 payed and debts by his my wife and her heirs payed and my body  
 honestlie becom to the said Countess and further to be shown to you difference shall you  
 make and consent by the advice of my executors upon I make and ordain  
 my next of kinne and friends shall in such and such manner to be my overseers to  
 see my present Testament and last will performed to be aiding and assisting  
 to my said wife in the execution of his my said will and Testament that I will give  
 and bequeath to you for your pains and trouble and assistance in that  
 behalf in the said County of North and beside his or your costs and charges to be borne  
 if you shall give in the County of North
