 being at the makinge hereof in good state of bodilie health, And of sound and perfect remembrance blessed
 be God. doe make this my last will and Testament containinge therein my full minde and last, first and
 remembrance of doe becomende my soule into the handes of Almightie my maker Oreate trusting by the mercie
 of his sonne Iesu Christe my Redeemer to be saved And my bodye to be buried at the discretion of mine
 Exoruto hereunder written or otherwise before it shall please god to appointe the same And as concerninge such
 thinges as goddeth shall please god of his goodnes to bestow and enable me of gins & dispoos of them as
 followeth Item I give towards the maintenance of Soringe Church five shillings Item I give and bequeath to the
 relik of the soule of Soringe ten shillings to be distributed unto at the discretion of the churchwardens for the year
 Item I give and bequeath to Alice my daughter and her heirs all my house hold stuff and ymplem^{ts} of house hold excepte
 her owne wardrobe and the best brass pot Item I bequeath of gins and bequeath to Margarett my sonne twenty
 shillings of lawfull english money Item I give and bequeath to my sonne Thomas the sonne of Tomm pounce of
 like lawfull money of England Item I give and devise to Samuel my sonne ten shillings of like lawfull
 money Item I give and devise to Margarett my sonne ten shillings of like lawfull money
 of England And also of gins and devise to my said sonne Margarett All that my house hold stuff of free hold
 land containinge by estimation one acre or more or less together with all the trees and wood xx
 gardenes & things in and aboute the same or any or proffitts of the same lyinge & beinge in Soringe in the parish of
 Soringe aforesaid in the aforesaid County of Surrey the same land lyinge from Soringe to Eggham on the east xx
 side of it
 singularly excepte to give the said Margarett and his heirs for ever Item I give and devise to my daughter xx
 Walter Soringe ten shillings of lawfull English money Item I give and devise to Margarett the sonne of Margarett
 Soringe one ewe and one lamb Item I give and devise to Barbara daughter of the said Margarett one ewe and one
 lamb Item I give and devise to Alice Edmonson daughter of Margarett Soringe my daughter lathie covered twenty
 shillings and one ewe and one lamb Item I give and devise to William the sonne of Thomas Soringe my sonne two
 ewes and two lammes All the said legages and somes of money forsover by me given bequeathed and devised my will
 and meaninge is shalbe paid by my Exoruto hereafter named within five Months next after my decease excepte
 the aforesaid ten shillings to the soule of the said Margarett the same is shalbe paid by my said Exoruto all on the day of my
 buriall And the residue of my goods Chattels Chattels movables and immovables not forsover given bequeathed
 nor devised of gins and devise to William Soringe my eldest sonne of male sole Exoruto of this my last
 will and Testament So for my debts paid my funeral expenses discharge and this my last will & Testament I for
 And I Corow doe make constitute and ordaine my truste and well beloved freinds Henry Cudman and Saunders
 of Eggham in the County of Surrey and John Saunders the younger of Eggham aforesaid Camer to give or
 give Margarett my sonne to be the Exorutors of this my last will and towards the same paymes herein to be bestowed of
 gins to each of them the sonne of five shillings & eight pence In witness whereof I the said William Soringe the elder
 to this my last will & Testament have subscribed my hand and Seale the Twentieth day of July in the seventh
 year of the Kinge of England and of Scotland the Thyme & Actes
