Item I give unto my Sister Mary Helpe an Ewe and a lamb
and a fall of Bees
Item I give unto my Sister Anne Steeb one Ewe and a lamb
and a fall of Bees and a great Brass pot wth some
wax my Grandmother.

Item I give unto my Sister Sara Steeb one Ewe and a
Lamb and a fall of Bees, and my desire is that she first
shame should be for my Wife, and she had an Ewe and
a Lamb of my Mother's William Helpe.

Item I give unto my godson Thomas one of
my sister's Lamb to be sold when it is weaned
Item I give to Catherine Beldan my goddaughter one of
my sister's Lamb to be sold when it is weaned.

Item I do by this my last will and testament ordaine, constitute and
make Mary my well known wife my executor and sole
of all my goods and shall my executor my wife and
my wife to take and enjoy in all things and beneficial
manner as she shall think fit her husband will.

Item I do desire my Mother, John Steeb and John
to be overseer of this my last will and testament
written in confirmation of this my last will I do give unto
all my marks in the County of York that are under
named.
