in with the garden & the house which I dwell in
& Thomas my son which I make my will
& devise

And I do desire my executors John Robert &
Thomas & my son John Robert to be the first
last will fulfilled & give to me for their payment
to be taken out of a box to be reasonable
charged with a piece
