two hundred of good and lawfull money of england to  
be payed unto the said John godden with in one half  
year after my decease my will and meaning is that  
the said ten pound that he shal have in his possession  
of mill lands: Item I give unto John godden  
my brother the summe of five pillinge upon the  
first daye demande after my decease

Item I give unto Harriette daughter my godson  
ten pillinge

Item I give unto Isabell Hamlett my goddaughter  
ten pillinge

Item I give unto Elisabeth godden my god daughter  
ten pillinge: Item I give unto my wiff Jacus  
godden my brother Christopher daughter my wed  
dowre and all the rest of my wearinge apparell  
beinge wollen and linnen to be equallye divided  
betwixen the said Elisabeth godden and Jacus godden

Item likewise I give unto the above named John  
godden my eldest brother some hundred of my  
latten to be paid it yearly after my decease  
and I give all the rest of my goods and chattels  
unto Nicholas godden my brother Christopher some  
and also the said Nicholas godden shall my full  
and whole executor: discharging of all debts due  
from my estate in my will with the said Nicholas also  
that shall be let my funeralle
