 five pounds for the use of the said poor
 of my buriall and the heirs male of his

 And for want of such heirs male of his

 tenements and to the use of the said
 poor of my buriall and the heirs male
 of his body lawfullie begotten as afore
 said I give to my sonne William Waterer
 my eldest daughter - to be paid by my
 Executors when she shall attaine to the
 age of xxij years, or be married, or
 shall attaine to the age of xxij years, or
 be married, which shall come first, and
 if either of these my said daughters shall
 fortune to dye, before they be taxable
 of their bequeathed Legacies, then I will
 that the said Legacies, except one - to be
 deducted and given to my youngest
 sonne Thomas Waterer I give to my
 youngest sonne Thomas Waterer all my
 wearing apparel except my best coat
 and my best hat and all my goods and
 chattels whatsoever not herein
 bequeathed, I give and bequeath to my
 said sonne John Waterer, whom I make
 executor of this my last will and
 Testament, upon condition also that he
 shall paye and discharge all my debts
 and funeral expences, and doe give
 sufficient security to my creditors
 hereafter mentioned in my said will
 which is as follows, to wit, I give full
 power unto my said sonne John Waterer

 Testament, to sell my said goods
 and to let out my lands, and
 to do all such other things as he shall
 see cause to doe, and I give unto
 my said sonne John Waterer for his
 pains and charges in this behalf
