 Johanna my biggest brass bottle. Item I give to my
 daughter Hono my next biggest brass bottle. Item I will
 that my two daughters Johanna & Hono, and my sonne
 william shall have every of them a sowerme of land
 to have sowerme to be delivred unto them, witegin
 three yeare after my decease. Item I give my house
 and garden plott, lying at westend in the parrysh of
 Essex to Hono my wife, during her naturall life, and
 after her deathe to her child never borne & to be
 enjoyed for ever, and if she dye witegin an child
 lawfully begotten of her own body, then I give it to
 my sonne william and his heyres for ever. All the
 rest of my good and chattels, moveable, and immoveable,
 I give unto Hono my wife, witegin I make sole
 executrix of this my last will & testament. In witness
 whereof I have put to my hand the day and yeare
 abovesaid.
