of Harrow in the pish of Alders in the countie of Surrey yoman beinge sick in bedde but of sound
ginnon unto almighty god in good and quiet memorye I doe ordaine and make this my present last will
testament in manner and forme followinge that is to saye In pmissioe I will and bequeathe me soule
unto Almighty god my maker and Redeemer trustinge to be saved by the death & merite of his onely
sonne and my onely Saviour Iesus Christ and by no other meanes and my bodye unto the church from whence
it was taken from I will and bequeathe unto the poore people of the pish of Alders twentie pcentages of
lawfull monye of England to be payed and distributed by my Executor hereafter named within one moneth
after my decease flem I will and bequeathe unto Elizabeth Hamond my daughter fifteen poundes of
good and lawfull monye of England to be payed within one yere after her marriage or when she
shall Accomplish the age of six and twenty yeares at wch time of her two as that first portion by
my Executor hereafter named flem I will and bequeathe unto Dorothy Hamond my daughter fifteen
poundes of lawfull monye of England to be payed within one yere after her marriage or when
she shall Accomplish the age of six and twenty yeares at wch time of her two as that first
portion by my Executor hereafter named flem I will and bequeathe unto Jane my daughter ffourte
poundes of the like lawfull monye of England to be payed by my Executor hereafter named unto
her when she shall accomplish the age of six and twenty yeares flem I will and bequeathe unto
my daughter ffourte poundes of the like lawfull monye of England to be payed by my Executor
hereafter named unto her when she shall accomplish the age of six and twenty yeares
flem I give unto Katherine my wife the one halfe of the maner of Gades within the parish of
I nome Dooch and three akers of meadow and two acres upon the land or out of the barn and in the
like manner out of the parish of Dooch and two akers of oates one acre and one yardeinge halfe
and one meawinge waite and ffive Depps and three bags to be delivered by my Executor hereafter
named yemediably after my decease flem I give unto Phillip Golden of Harrow in the countie of Surrey
yoman my sonne in lawe wch married my eldest daughter ffive pcentages of lawfull monye of England
and I give also unto John Golden my Godson the somme of five poundes of the like lawfull monye of
England to be payed to him by me my Executor within one moneth after
my decease flem I give unto Joseph Brooker of wett wether in the countie of Surrey yoman wch
married my daughter ffive pcentages of lawfull monye of England and I give also unto Thomas
Brooker my Godson the somme of five poundes of the like lawfull monye of
England to be payed to him by me my Executor within one moneth after my decease flem I give
unto all other my god children out of the parish of lawfull monye of England to be payed by
my Executor hereafter named all other my goodes and the alowes house hold stuffe furniture of what
nature and proprietye soever they be after my debts and charges payed my funeral expenses satisfied
and my bodye decently buried I give unto Richard Hamond my sonne in lawe I doe ordaine and make
to be my wyfe and sole Executor of this my present last will & testament and also I doe
ordaine and make my sonninge ffrendes Thomas Kibridgen of Alders in the countie of Surrey
yoman and Richard Ed of Peire in the countie of Surrey husbandman to be surseors to this my last
will & testament bindinge them for their paines therein taken these pcentages and ffower poundes to each of
them and about their charges bounde And I do hereunto signe my hande & affixe my name all
former wiche by me made and doe acknowledge this to be my last will & testament in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seale this day and yere first above written in the presence of us
