 and bequeath unto all my three daughters viz. Ann Fyot Margaret and Elizabeth the  
 sum of forty pound a piece of lawful money of England to be paid into any of them upon  
 my said decease the said sum of fourty pound of each one and twenty years from the day  
 my said decease before my said decease the said sum of fourty pound to be paid into any of them upon  
 the said money so by me given shall remaine and distributed unto the residue of my  
 said residue equally Item I give unto any of my three daughters the sum of five pound of  
 lawful money of England and all my goods and chattels not given and not given to  
 and bequeath unto Elizabeth my wife widow of me and make my will and testament  
 only and sole executor of my last will and testament and to give & bequeath  
 by me declared in this my said will declared And also of due nominate and appoint my  
 very good friends Edward Ayer of Exeter Esquire and Robert Fyot of Exeter Esquire  
 executor of my said last will and testament and to give and bequeath to the residue of my  
 my will fulfilled and for my more comfort hereof I give unto any of my  
 three daughters the sum of five pound and bequeath all my goods and chattels to be paid by my said  
 executor and to do so and make void all other wills and testaments executed and made by me  
 whatsoever made written and declared in witness whereof I have subscribed my name and seal the  
 day & year above written.
