 or last wille by me made before the daye of the date  
 hereof. Item I will & bequeath to my sonne  
 I begin my sonne first Phillip  
 Item I will & bequeath to Elizabeth my daughter  
 the wife of William Smith of the Burgh in the  
 county of Essex) half a dozen of powder shot  
 of six middle size; and one paxer of flaxen paxer  
 and one paxer of smyggen paxer  
 Item I will & bequeath to my souldier now borne &  
 hereafter, of the name of Robert Smith my daughter  
 to either of them five shillings to be paid wylm one  
 year next after my decease  
 Item all the rest of my goods & chattels not before bequeath  
 ed, I will & bequeath to Thomas Delyn my sonne  
 whome I make my full & sole executour this my  
 last will & testament. In witness whereof I have  
 subscribed st. my hand & seale the daye & yere first  
 aboue writtten.
