pawys being a spake balle and all effects of my apparel  
of yale and bequeathes to my daughtres Alis stebensone and unto  
my sonnes Edward wateres w/ as per to be dydall a badeys  
between thibet fibre and bequeathes to my sonnes Edward wateres  
it arthe w/ left gare w/ Edward my sonnes Edward  
wateres my thalke apothecary all the cost of my toads  
wateres to obte it he besydes my apothecary to take unto me  
my daughtres stebensone for Edward the tylings cost per  
a pult and is owing Edward being to her tylings  
Edward xviij a yere & 3 years to take & give pult  
unto Edward and balle fibre & his ayments of badeys  
1620 Edward the 4th yeres of the Raigne of Edward
