 his mind full of grace & comfort in mind & forme following
 first & principally my soule into the hands of Almighty god
 Jesus Christ, & my body to the party to be buried in testament
 place at the discretion of my Executors. And I give to and
 bequeath to Martha my wife my house & all my lands lying in
 some parishes within making any lease or term of years or
 dwelling all the said lands & houses & houses & houses
 out of hand to my Executors & Administrators & assigns
 some parishes to the satisfaction of the said particular Legacies
 Martyn my eldest daughter to be paid to her by my
 Executors upon the full term to the age of one & twenty years.
 And I give to Mary my daughter to be paid to her by my
 Executors upon the full term to the age of one & twenty years.
 I give also to George Martyn my sonne to be paid to
 him upon the full term to the age of one & twenty years.
 I give also to Elizabeth Martyn my daughter to be paid
 to her upon the full term to the age of one & twenty years.
 And I give to Sarah Martyn my daughter to be paid
 to her upon the full term to the age of one & twenty years.
 And my will & meaning is that if any of my foresaid children
 happen to dye before the time appointed in any of the
 said parishes & should receive by the said Legacies what part
 of the portion of the same one or more of the said children
 equally amongst the survivors. And my will & meaning is that
 the time of utterance for the payment of the said Legacies shall
 begin at the feast of St Michael the last day of the next after
 my decease. And my will & meaning is that if any of the said
 children shall happen to dye before the full term to be paid
 truly upon the said parishes & some of the same parishes into the hands of
 my Executors as is appointed, that then & from thenceforth the
 said parishes & some of the same parishes given unto the said Martha my
 wife for the payment of the said Legacies before specified shall
 for ever be taken & determined. And my will & meaning is that
 my Executors to give & give & Administrators shall
 have full power & authority to enter upon my said lands
 & all my lands for & during the term of the said parishes
 & are empowered to the intent that the Legacies may be truly paid.
 And I give will & bequeath all my foresaid house & lands in
 Shropshire after the full term to the said James Martyn my sonne & heirs to him & his heirs
 forever.
