

In the name of god amen the third day of April. 1632. I John Hollaway son of the parish of Offham in the County of Surrey do make constitute ordaine and appoint this my last will and testament, in maner and forme following (scilicet) first I comend my soule into the hands of almighty god my maker and Jesus Christ my saviour and redeemer who I hope will accept of it in mercy. And my bodie I bequeath & comitt unto the earth from whence it came, and to be buried wthin the church of Offham aforesaid in and according to Christian buriall. I give unto the parish church of Offham aforesaid twelve pound of current English monie, Item I give unto my wife Elizabeth the sum of ten pound of current English monie, Item I give unto my sonne John Hollaway twelve pound, Item I give unto my sonne Thomas Hollaway twelve pound, Item I give unto my sonne Sidrall Hollaway twelve pound, Item I give unto my wife Elizabeth Hollaway the sum of twenty shillings of current English monie to be paid unto her wthin the year after my decease upon condition that shee my said wife do suffer all the charges w^{ch} shee shall have in respect to be reasonably and quietly taken and varied away by my exors and to her selfe Item I give unto my daughter Elizabeth the wife of Robt Crigg the sum of ten shillings of current English monie And to her said Robt Crigg the sum of ten shillings to be paid by my exors wthin six monthes after my decease. Item I give unto Robt Crigg the sum of ten pound of current English monie, Item I do make constitute and appoint hereby my daughter Joane Hollaway my sole executrix of all and singular my goods realt and personall and to her selfe and her assigns, her exors and assigns, lastly I do intreate my trustie and wellbelovd friend Symon marner and John Shrubbe to be the overseers of this my last will & testament and to see it performed according to the true intent and meaning hereof, In consideration of theire love and service I do give and bequeath unto both of them two shillings a peece to be paid by my said executrix wthin six monthes after my decease. In witness whereof I the said John Hollaway, the said Elizabeth my wife and the said Robt Crigg have set our hands and seals the day and year first above written in the presence of
