 pounds be raysed with certayne goodes the residue I will appointe to be paid to the use  
 of my daughters, the I will and appointe that after the tenne years be expired  
 that then my wife shall have five pounds by the year with the benefite of her landes  
 during her naturall life out of my free landes, and further my will and mind is that of the residue  
 any overplus of money out of the rents that my wife is appointed to pay over and above the  
 raising of the forty pounds for my daughters, that then the money remaininge shall be to the  
 toward the raising of twenty poundes the residue I meane to give to my youngest sonne if  
 my wife Marye shall decease before the tenne years be expired, that then my will  
 and mind is my eldest sonne shall pay and make up the forty poundes if my wife do not  
 the my will and mind is that my eldest sonne shall pay out of my free land twenty poundes  
 of lawfull money to my youngest sonne William four years after the tenne years be expired  
 before mentioned and if my eldest sonne shall fail to make payment of the same  
 money before witten that then my will and mind is that my youngest sonne shall have and  
 enjoye and have of my free lande vale by the name of executours to him and his exors  
 for ever, the my will and mind is that if my eldest sonne shall decease before

cometh to the age of twenty and one years  
 shall pay the said twenty pound formerly  
 ten years after he shall come to the land  
 and one become barren then one <sup>blacke</sup> <sup>year</sup>  
 the my will is that my wife mary shall have  
 for the and the some of the and all the rest  
 of the forty pound for my four daughters  
 daughter mary and joyne bested standing in the left  
 of years to my daughter dorothy and another standing  
 the of years to my sonne and furnace standing in the left  
 after his mother decease the of years my daughter alice  
 after her mother decease the of years my daughter  
 after her mother decease the of years to my youngest  
 sonne after my decease the of will and bequeath  
 unto my wife all the rest of my goods  
 and bequeath unto my wife all the rest of my  
 beloved friends John Brister and William Norrish  
 after my last will and testament and for every  
 year James taking year of years to every of  
 them five shillings in respect of years unto my  
 sonne and shall the days and years  
 above written
