Item I will give and bequeath to the Church of yorke  
one yelken, one ball, and Subbord, and a forme, and three Cope, a Dalm of yorke  
two breast yoke, one Caudron, all which being valued is worth seven poundes to be delivred  
unto my daughter Annis, at the age of one and twenty yeeres, if then she shall have need of her  
other wife to remaine in the handes of my Executors, until she shall have need of her  
Item I will give and bequeath unto my daughter Annis Underwood, thirteen poundes  
in money, to be paid unto her by my Executors when she shall accomplish the age of one  
and twenty yeeres.

Item I will give and bequeath to my five godchildren six poundes  
Item I will give and bequeath to my daughter Jeane respectively  
Item it is my will that all my goods and Chattells, booke and Ballad with me, doones, by receipt  
after my decease, by my overseer and other honest neighbors, and at the best advantage  
and the consideration thereof, to remaine for the maintenance of my wife Jeane Underwood  
till she be dead, and the said five poundes to be equally divided betweene  
my two daughters Jeane respectively and Annis Underwood.

Item my will is that all my household stuffe with in doore, and out doore, shall  
and remaine to the use of my wife Jeane Underwood during her life, and after her decease  
by my overseer and other neighbors, and by them divided to my two daughters equally  
Item I doe make my loving wife Jeane Underwood my whole and sole executrix  
of this my last will and Testament, do seeing her to see my debts and legacies, and funeral  
charges discharged.

Item I nominate and ordaine my loving friends William Bray, William Richardson  
and George Shildon to be the overseers of this my last will and Testament, desiring them  
to see the same performed according to my true meaning, and for my wife Jeane  
I give unto them that it is in their power
