 Nere left in my hands for the use & behoof of the said Gilbert.)
 So it is in all thirty shillings to be paid by my executrix, after
 he shall come to the age of one & twenty years, when he shall
 lawfully demand it. Item I give to wille^m Nere my franchised
 one shilling. Item I give to Francis Nere my franchised one
 shilling. Item I give to Moses Nere my franchised one shilling
 Item I give to my daughter Anne Nere all my goods, leases,
 cattells, & chattells whatsoever to her & her heirs for ever
 my debts being first paid & funerals expenses discharged, And
 I do make & ordaine the said Anne Nere of sole Executrix
 of this my last will & testam^t. In witness whereof I have
