 of August in the year of our Lord God. 1636:
 I John Vargis of Northampton shire do hereby
 and do hereby my last will and testament
 in manner and form following: Whereas I
 will and bequeath my soul to the keeping of
 Almighty God, bequeath to him for Jesus Christ
 my soul, to have mercy on it and to rest it
 in. And for my worldly goods, I do bequeath
 of them after this manner.
 First I do bequeath to my son John Vargis
 the sum of ten pounds. Item I bequeath to
 my son Arthur Vargis five shillings
 and to my daughter Dorice - one shilling.
 To and to my daughter Elizabeth five
 shillings. And to my daughter Mary five
 shillings. And likewise to my daughter Anne
 five shillings: And for the rest of my
 goods and chattels, I bequeath them all
 to my wife Mary whom I make the
 executrix of this my last will and testament
 In witness whereof I have set to my hand
 and subscribed my name, the day and
 years above named.
