 a Christian I do give and bequeath unto Susan my daughter
 my table in the hall & the Joynted staires, also my bedstead and
 bed and all things thereto belonging standing in the place
 Also a brass pott a skillett & a stinnel also my willow two chaires
 standing in the place & also my biggest whit faced bullard
 I do give & bequeath unto Susan my daughter the last woman
 in the house to the whole of my goods & chattels what soeuer
 my debts & funeral expenses discharged I give unto my said two
 daughters to be equally divided between them And my will
 and desire is that it shall be full well and continued in
 the house where I now dwell that they shall alwaye be
 daughters Susan my daughter & Susan in the said house to be and to
 you goods so long as they shall continue unmarried
 And I doe ordaine the appointment John Stottson my brother in law
 to be executor of this my last will & testament

I do all other wills gifts legacies and bequests by me heretofore
 written given & bequeathed I doe by this present make to the
 word & of none effect & do acknowledge this to be my last will &
 testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand &
 the xxvth day of May first above written
