Declare this my last will and Testament in maner and
forme following first I give to my loving wife all the linnen
in my house witt id mine to her desiring her to bestow the
Linnen Amongst her children According to the Chyrbills
fitting and also I give to my wife what is before mentioned
five pound and I give to my sone John Snelling three shillings
and four pence and I give to my sone William Snelling and
Andrew Snelling each of them five pound and I give to my
Daughters Mary Snelling and Elizabeth Snelling each of them
four pound as for the linnen excepted if it shold happen
that my wife shold not have out in woorke to pay these legesed
witt id before mentioned then that my wife and children shall
be abated an equale part alike and so be contented to take it
Accordingly ad it will be out and also if it shold happen
that my wife witt id before mentioned be deceasid after my
Decease that then her part of goodes shall remaine Amongst her
children proportionally at that instant equall to be divided
amongst them and shall not touch any goodes from them and also
I make my loving wife heile executor to pay these legesed witt
id before mentioned upon the first day of may which shall
be in the year of our lord god 1638 and I desire my two
loving Nabor Josua Whittes and Thomas Smith to be Overseers
for the performace of this my last will and Testament in
wittid whereof my hand set my hand
