

Memorandum, in the Month of December in the year of
our Lord 1638. Margarett Honour of ~~Woking~~ ~~Wimborne~~
lack of body but of effort & memory did make this her
Munificative will as followeth vizt^{ly} shee did speak
these words or the like in effect in the presence of
Robert Honour her father, w^{ch} is since her death as
Dorea her, and Agnes her mother, Item shee did give
unto the two sonnes of Johⁿ her sister w^{ch} unto
William Fortu Hillings and unto Thomas three
pounds. Item shee alsoe did give unto John Wythott
the sonne of Agnes her sister three pounds, Item
shee gave to John Davers the sonne of Elizabeth
her sister three pounds. Item shee alsoe gave unto the
two sonnes of Robert Honour her brother, Robert &
Thomas Fortu Hillings a poire all to be paid
w^{ch} in one year next after her decease. And shee
w^{ch} rest remaininge of her Twentie pounds shee
did give unto Agnes her mother in some shee maketh
her executrix &c.
