 the house barns and edifices & the land therunto belonginge as aforesaid unto my youngest Sonne Richard
 Beukle ~~to hold the lease duringe his residue of yeeres that shall then to come~~
~~and after his decease to hold the same duringe the residue of yeeres that shall then to come~~
 Item I give unto Ailes my wyfe all my household stuffe
 all the said house hold stuffe unto my youngest Sonne Richard Beukle ~~and after her decease I give~~
 to him and to his heirs for ever and ever Item I give unto my daughter Jane one Chubb that standeth in the
 kitchen & one little Arme Table standing in the kitchen Chamber & one bedstead & bedd cover for now & hereafter
 & one little Arme bedstead & bedd and all that belongeth unto the same which standeth in the last row the hall
 Item I give unto my daughter Jane Beukle twenty poundes of Lawfull mony of England to be payed unto her
 next Christmas Day which shall come next after my decease Item I give unto John Beukle my eldest Sonne
 John Beukle twenty poundes Item I give unto my daughter Anne Beukle twenty poundes Item I give unto
 my daughter Elizabeth Beukle twenty poundes Item I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Beukle twenty poundes Item I give
 out the rest of my Goodes both Real and Personal that is unbestowed & not given I give it to my Ailes my
 wife whom also I make my sole executrix of this my last will & Testament to take my goodes & to paye
 all my Debts and legacies accordyng to the true meaning & purpose And I desire my welbelovyd freinde George
 Dand & Thomas John Sturridge both of Burghie to be my overseers to see this my last will & Testament
 rightlie and truly executed accordyng to the true intent & meaning of the same and to save their charges
 bene or to be above their paynt whiche shall be expended about this and In witness whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand and seale in perfect memorie the day and yeere first above written
