The last will & testament of Thomas Stone of Newaco in ye County
of Surrey expressed made & ye 4th day of April 1639.

James I bequeath my soule into ye hands of Almighty God in ye merit &
intercession of Iesus Christ my Lord & Saviour.
Ite I bequeath my body into ye earth to be buried in Christian manner & to discharge
ye costs of my funeral I will & appoint 5*li*.
Ite I give & bequeath unto my ~~brother~~ ^{daughter} Anne Stone 10*li*
Ite I give unto my sister Anne Stone & her husband two shillings
in freewill giving chest & a pair of sheets.

Ite I give to my sister Anne Stone 10*li*. halfe a dozen of Lenten
Ite I give to my brother within 10*li*. two little chests. one white
and another my wearing clothes & my working tools.
Ite I give unto my wife and she bequeath my other wearing clothes.
Ite I give to my brother ^{John} Stone 10*li*. I doe make him the full & whole
executor of this my will & testament. & doe bequeath unto him the remainder
of all my good realty & personallty of what nature so ever of massaco
Ite I doe give my wife Anne Stone the full & whole
of the ^{house} ~~house~~ of this my last will, & doe bequeath unto any
of the ^{children} ~~children~~ of this my last will 5*li*.
