This April, Surrey Archaeological Society will be running three days of community archaeology in Old Woking!

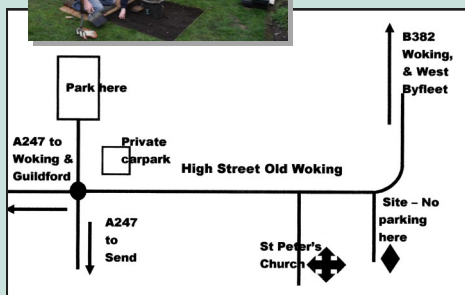
